Preschool

I have put the little ones into two different groups for certain areas of our lessons. The older kids work more with colors/markers and hand-eye coordination skills. I include them in the baking and meal preparation as well as making sure they are setting a good example for the younger children. I may sit and read books and point to a character and ask them to identify it or show them pictures of items and ask them to repeat the word of whatever I may be pointing out! I am amazed at their progress, manners, and respect for each other on a daily basis!
