Supplies

The kids are having so much fun playing in this beautiful fall weather we have been having lately. Please make sure your child has all the necessary items to play outdoors such as a jacket and shoes. Unless it's raining or snowing, I try to get the kids out as often as possible, even on a bit of a brisk day!

Learning Time - Sign Language

I love teaching the little ones new words and ways to communicate. It's super cute seeing the older kids get involved in the teaching process to the younger kids. All of the kids use such good manners throughout the day that is had almost become second nature!!



More - Touch the fingertips of both hands before the chest with palms facing down. The right hand can be brought up to meet the left from slightly lower position.

Please - Make a circle with the right flat hand over the heart.



Thank-you - Touch the lips with the fingertips of one or both flat hands, then move the hands forward until the palms are facing up. It is natural to smile and nod the head while making this sign.

Shoes - Strike the thumb sides of both closed hands together a few times.

Socks - Point both index fingers down. Rub them up and down against each other alternately.

Hot - Place the fingers and thumb of the right C hand at the sides of the mouth, then quickly pivot the hand forward to the right.

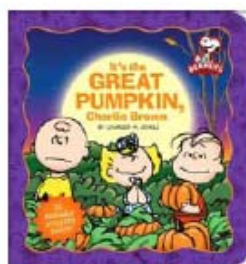
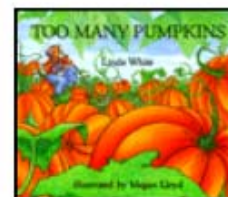
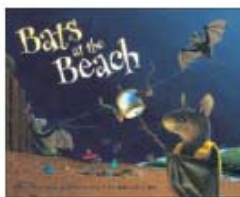


Cold - Hold up both S hands in front of the chest and shake them.
